Historic Seattle Spring Members Meeting 3/4/21

Twenty-two members and non-members attended the 3/4/21 Members Meeting held electronically via Zoom. Staff was represented by Kji Kelly, Naomi West, Eugenia Woo, Jane Davies, Cindy Hughes, Taelore Rhoden, and Danielle Quenell. The Historic Seattle Council was represented by David Yeaworth and Rick Sever.

Community Events Manager Taelore Rhoden welcomed meeting participants and shared Historic Seattle's mission statement: Saving Meaningful Places to Foster Lively Communities. She also thanked the Underwriting Partners of Historic Seattle's programming.

Taelore read Historic Seattle's draft Land Acknowledgement: "At Historic Seattle we know that our properties and programs occupy the unceded traditional territories of the Coast Salish Peoples. This acknowledgement is not a substitute for developing relationships with Indigenous communities or for honoring Indigenous stories as we share our collective history but is a first step in recognizing the people whose land we occupy."

David Yeaworth, Historic Seattle Council Chair, was introduced. He called the Members Meeting to order at 5:30pm, and thanked the staff who worked hard to put together the meeting. He said that he saw a lot of familiar faces in attendance, as well as some unfamiliar ones, and that was inspiring to him.
