Historic Seattle Summer Members Meeting 6/3/21 Via Zoom

Twenty-six members and non-members attended the 6/3/21 Members Meeting held electronically via Zoom. Staff was represented by Kji Kelly, Naomi West, Jane Davies, Cindy Hughes, Taelore Rhoden, and Jeff Murdock. The Historic Seattle Council was represented by David Yeaworth.

Community Events Manager Taelore Rhoden welcomed meeting participants and shared Historic Seattle's mission statement: Saving Meaningful Places to Foster Lively Communities. She also thanked the Underwriting Partners of Historic Seattle's programming.

Taelore read Historic Seattle's Land Acknowledgement: "At Historic Seattle we know that our properties and programs occupy the unceded traditional territories of the Coast Salish Peoples. This acknowledgment is not a substitute for developing relationships with Indigenous communities or for honoring Indigenous stories as we share our collective history but is a first step in recognizing the people whose land we occupy."
