



Walking in Eva's Shoes was an event hosted by the Save the Stone Cottage committee in January 2021. Participants relived history by "walking in Eva's shoes" from the Alki Lighthouse to the Stone Cottage, symbolically recreating the 1930s journey that Eva Falk and her family took.

At the 2021 event, history volunteers told the fascinating stories behind some remarkable locations we have right here in our own backyard on Alki, the Birthplace of Seattle.
